

### **Graduate Program in Sciences and Culture**

This program covers multiple sciences related to human life, and its purpose is to graduate researchers or professional workers who can conduct interdisciplinary research studies—involving such preconditions for life as clothing, food, and shelter or such areas as psychology, culture, welfare, and education—in order to deal with diverse issues in the changing life environments. Consequently, candidates are required not only to have completed their master's studies in one of these areas but also to be equipped with abilities to integrate a broad range of knowledge in interdisciplinary research work. They must demonstrate their advanced knowledge in the fields above, aptitude for flexible thinking, and determination to take on interdisciplinary research work.
